





JUDGMENT

Pro se appellant Lonnlie Davis has appealed the dismissal of his complaint against John Hancock. Hancock has moved for summary disposition. We grant the motion. John Hancock is not subject to the Freedom of Information Act and plaintiff has not plausibly alleged that he is a participant or beneficiary within the meaning of ERISA. See 29 U.S.C. § 1132(c)(1). Consequently, we affirm the district court's dismissal, pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6), of plaintiff's complaint.
