I represent Cora Kerton and will be filing a Petition for Certiorari on her behalf. I am requesting a sixty day extension to file my Petition for Certiorari. I received a final decision from the New Jersey Supreme Court on March 8, 2019. It is my belief that the issues in this case are of national importance to the law enforcement community as well as other first responders who are called upon in times of emergency and are oftentimes injured. I understand that the required filing time is within 90 days of entry of the decision from the New Jersey Supreme Court. My present filing deadline is the date of June 6, 2019. If the sixty days extension is granted, the new filing deadline will be August 6, 2019.
