Dear Mr. Suter:


I'm in receipt of the *Writ of Certiorari* packet, yesterday (7/24/2018). According to my records, the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals (Denver, CO.) denied my *Certificate of Appealability* on May 1, 2018. That would mean my *computation of time deadline* would be Wednesday; August 1, 2018.

There is no possible way that I can have my *Writ of Certiorari* packet completed, copied and sent to you within this time frame. In order for me to have access to the Law Library, I have to request the access a week in advance by signing up on a sheet left by the Law Library Supervisor in the cellhouse and we are only allowed two (2) hours at any given time.
