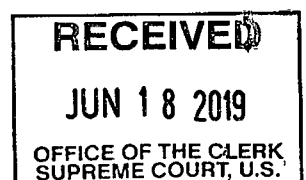
APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
TO THE SUPERIOR COURT OF PENNSYLVANIA

TO THE HONORABLE SAMUEL A. ALITO, JR., ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE  
SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES AND CIRCUIT JUSTICE FOR THE THIRD  
CIRCUIT:

Petitioner, Travis W. Matthews prays for a 60 day extension of  
time to file his petition for certiorari in this Court, to and  
including August 28, 2019. The final order of the Supreme Court of  
Pennsylvania was entered on April 1, 2019, denying Petitioner's  
application for discretionary review and the time to petition for  
certiorari expires on June 29, 2019. This application is being filed  
more than 10 days before that date. Copies of the order denying  
discretionary review and the Opinion of the Superior Court of  
Pennsylvania are attached herewith. The jurisdiction of this court  
is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1257(a).

As shown in the attached opinion, this case involves questions of  
whether the evidence was sufficient to establish Petitioner committed  
the crimes of which he was convicted when the victim reported to the  
police that he was robbed by two African American men and Petitioner  
is caucasian and the victim never identified Petitioner as being one  
of those men,

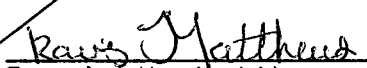
Petitioner needs this additional time to properly prepare his



petition for certiorari, since he is now proceeding pro se because his appointed appellate counsel was only appointed to represent Petitioner in state court, and therefore needs this additional time to familiarize himself with the procedures for preparing the petition and to study the applicable case law.

Wherefore, Petitioner respectfully requests that an order be entered extending the time to petition for certiorari to and including August 28, 2019.
