MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

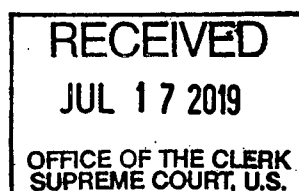
Petitioner, Daniel Masson, pro se, pursuant to Rules of the Supreme Court, Rule 30.2, moves this Court to extend the time for filing his Petition for Writ of Certiorari for 30 days, and in support will show:

1. This Motion is filed in good faith and not for the purpose of delay.
2. Petitioner submitted the written draft of his Petition (including Appendices) to law clerks on June 27, 2019 for word processing. This was later than anticipated.
3. Petitioner was concerned that, due to the late submission as well as the additional time required for proofing/corrections, there is a risk that the Court may receive his Petition several days later than the first 30 day extension deadline of August 1, 2019, which was granted by the Court.
4. Petitioner understands that late submissions of Petitions for Writ of Certiorari are unacceptable by this Court. Although Petitioner is making every effort to

ensure that this Court will receive his Petition as close as possible to the first 30 day extension deadline of August 1, 2019, the additional 30 day extension he is requesting simply ensures that the Court will not receive his Petition late.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that this Honorable Court will enlarge the time for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari for 30 days or grant any other appropriate relief.


