

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AN WRIT OF CERTIORARI

DECLARATION OF RICHARD MASSE

I, Richard Masse declare as follows:

1. I am the pro se litigant and real party in interest herein. I am over the age of eighteen. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein and could competently testify concerning these facts if so required.

2. It is not possible for me to complete and file my brief by the due date of October 1, 2018. and I require a sixty-day extension of time in which to file my brief

3. I received the decision the decision from the United States Court of Appeals, 2nd Circuit July 3, 2018,

3. I am not a lawyer, have no legal help, and is neither easy nor quick for me to generate the required brief. I am without any funds whatsoever, and must try to borrow funds just to make the necessary photocopies to file and bind my brief and the appendixes thereto.
