O R D E R:

Henry Lee Craig, Mississippi prisoner # 76582, was convicted by a jury of murder and sentenced to life in prison. He seeks a certificate of appealability (COA) to challenge the district court’s dismissal of his 28 U.S.C. § 2254 petition as time barred.

To obtain a COA, Craig must make “a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right.” 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2). When the district court dismisses a § 2254 petition on procedural grounds without reaching the merits of the prisoner’s claims, this court will issue a COA “when the prisoner shows, at least, that jurists of reason would find it debatable whether the petition states a valid claim of the denial of a constitutional right and that jurists of

reason would find it debatable whether the district court was correct in its procedural ruling.” *Slack v. McDaniel*, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000).

Craig has failed to make the required showing. Consequently, his COA motion is DENIED. His motion for the appointment of counsel and leave to file a supplemental brief in support of his COA motion are likewise DENIED.

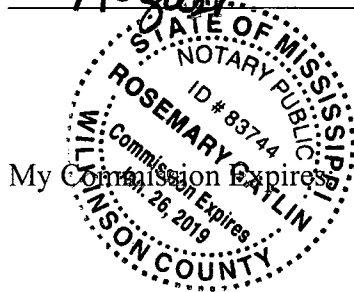
