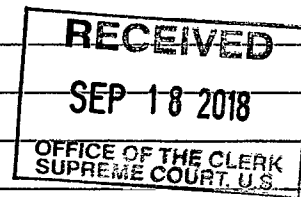

27 Segregation pending investigation for non Disciplinary reasons. I am doing every thing in my
28 Power to access the law library due to my need to research Case law in order to file my

1 Writ of Certiorari, I've spoken to Correctional officers Sergeants, lieutenants and
2 Even Submitted request forms to the librarian wich has been all to no avail so far.
3 While I am a lament at the law and need desperately the minimum of 4 hours a week in
4 Library access Per CCR title 5 § 3123(6) to do my research in order to file my Writ of Certiorari
5 in this Court. I pray that this Court grant Petitioner the necessary extension
6 of time to file His Writ of Certiorari.
