MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Appellant, Tony Scott, *pro se*, moves this Honorable Court for an order granting him an extension of time of sixty (60) days to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the above styled cause. In support of this motion, the Appellant states the following:

1. That the Appellant is presently required to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari with this Court by October 11, 2018.
2. The Appellant has never prepared any legal documents in his entire life *pro se*.
3. The time remaining for filing is insufficient to insure an adequate presentation of Appellant's argument on his Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
