

To the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States:

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, I request an extension of time in this case. I previously filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus and a motion of petitioner for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. In a letter dated October 1, 2018, the Court denied the petitioner's motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and the Court directed the petitioner to pay the docketing fee required by Rule 38(a) and submit a petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 by October 22, 2018. My office is in Tallahassee, and Hurricane Michael recently hit the Tallahassee area causing our office to be closed for several days (and during this time period, I was without power and internet). As a result, my office has been unable to complete the process of converting the appendix into the appropriate format.
