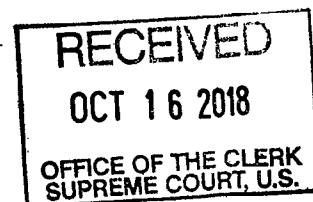

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE APPLICATION

1. Petitioner has no education concerning law writing nor law research.
2. According to Petitioner's computation of his 90 days in which his Certiorari is due has been determined to be on or around ~~December~~ December 6, 2018.
3. The officials and security here at Apalachee Correctional Institution have just made it mandatory that every inmate here can only have one (1) hour per visit per every 7-10 days. This would only leave the petitioner a maximum of only 6 hours of research AND in those 6 hours he needs to wait for a typist around 10-14 days to type his certiorari.
