APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
Due Extraordinary Circumstances.

To Associate Justice Elena Kagan, petitioners jurisdiction stmt.

Honorable Justice Kagan, Pet. In Re, Stanley E. Kornafel, layman, pro se, respectfully requests an extension of time to file his petition for writ of certiorari being under extraordinary circumstances.

The latest time to file would have been October 20 but due to legal, mental and physical hardships was hindered beyond his control. For good cause involving federal law and constitution's bearing on case petitioner pleads the deadline be extended 45 days to allow justice, fair and equal be served, with filing of the writ.

Legal Causation causing the lateness is that Petitioner had been overburdened in filing his appeal to the appeals court in another case 18-3241, which was filed around 5 October, 2018.

Although of the same court it is of no case matter or litigants relative to this case.

Mental hardship was having suffered impairing of thought process from two rounds of heart ablations surgery, which adversely affected the petitioner's memory, along with daily thinking on matters.

Physical hinderance which also played on the mental stability was having cancer and tumor is on medication for preparing of surgery, then also there is the skin cancer, while coping with age 77. A list of surgeons and doctors is available, for credibility.

The combination of three had so overwhelmed the layman void of any assistance that the immediate case fell behind schedule.


Reasons for granting the extension of time:
