**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI**

Petitioner, Manuel Enrique Camacho, pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the rules of the United States Supreme Court, respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time to and including September 18, 2018, within which to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari. The petition is due in this case on July 20, 2018. The Federal Public Defender's Office was appointed to represent Mr. Camacho in the United States District Court for the Western District of Arkansas and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit pursuant to an appointment under the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, as amended.

While the undersigned will not be representing Mr. Camacho on further appeal of this case, and will be moving to withdraw, she is requesting an extension of time to file his *pro se* petition on Mr. Camacho's behalf. Mr. Camacho requires more time in order to file his petition as the undersigned was informed that Mr. Camacho has not received any letters sent by counsel regarding his filing deadlines with this Court.

This extension is requested in order to allow Mr. Camacho sufficient time to research and prepare his petition, which was delayed because Mr. Camacho did not

receive the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeal's Opinion and Judgment in this matter, nor the undersigned's letter informing Mr. Camacho of the deadlines and information regarding filing a petition with this Court. Therefore, Mr. Camacho requests an extension of time until and including September 18, 2018.
