**APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THE
UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE SIXTH CIRCUIT**

To the Honorable Elena Kagan of the Sixth Circuit:

Petitioner Martin H. Leaf, requests an extension of time to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari for fifty-nine days from November 13, 2018 – until and including Friday January 4, 2019. The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals entered its judgment on July 12, 2018. A petition for rehearing and rehearing *en banc* was denied on August 15, 2018. The petition for writ of certiorari will expire on November 13, 2018.

I am attaching copies of the opinions of the lower court. This Court's jurisdiction is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

This case alleges unexpected and unwanted anti-Semitic racist messages in the film *Drive* and other media, using techniques found in sophisticated advertising - including messages not consciously noticed during normal viewing.

The questions involve whether the conditions imposed upon the Michigan Consumer Protection Act ("MCPA") – MCLA 445.903 *et seq.*, - by the Sixth Circuit Court Of Appeals, violate a consumer's: (1) First Amendment right to be free from unwanted messages; (2) Constitutional right to privacy under the Bill of Rights; and (3) Fifth Amendment Due Process Right to the consumer's chose in action because the consumer will no longer have a legal remedy to sue under the MCPA or any other statute for such violations, because of the conditions unjustifiably imposed by the Sixth Circuit.

I need an extension of time because, although I am an attorney, I am not being paid for this case and have already spent a tremendous amount of time and money on it because of the public issues involved. I am the power of attorney for my 84 year old mother, who is very ill and *requires* 24x7 care from her caregivers which I primarily pay for, and supervise, with no help yet from any insurance or any other government source for the last two years. This has caused, *especially recently*, a tremendous financial burden which has required me to work as much as possible to pay for the caregivers, which has not allowed me sufficient time to meet the deadline, which I have tried to do.

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If this extension is granted, myself and Samuel H. Gun will be applying for the Supreme Court Bar and Mr. Gun will file an appearance as attorney of record.
