Motion for Extension of Time

Therefore, having my writ of Habeas Corpus petition denied and that I am continuing pro-se in the filing of a writ of Certiorari application, I ask that the

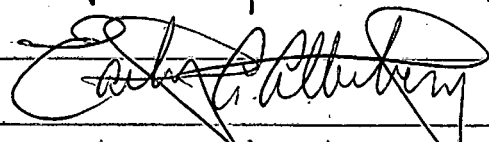
