

**DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PETITION FOR REHEARING**

The undersigned, doth depose and saith;

1. My name is Linda Scully and I am a plaintiff in the above titled cause of action.
2. My Writ of Cert to the US Supreme Court is currently due Mar. 7, 2019.
3. On Oct. 25, 2018, I went to draft an order in my mother's guardianship case, Cook County Case No. 13 P 4339 and I was body slammed by attorney Joseph Pieper when he tried to grab an order I had written up out of my hand. I then fell hard on my right foot, which caused me pain and damage because I have had surgeries on that foot and the foot contains pins. I then went immediately to my orthopedic surgeon who took x-rays and he found swollen tissues and strained ligaments. He told me to stay off my feet for two weeks and then return to him for reevaluation of when I can walk on that foot. That has happened numerous times, but numerous soft tissues were torn up when this happened, and I have only been able to put on a regular shoe this week. My foot has been in a boot type of cast which has had to be readjusted for more support of the damaged foot and I am still told to stay off my foot, which makes things hard when I have to go to the law library to get help with my pleadings.
4. I am indigent, have not been appointed pro bono counsel, (though I have tried numerous times—every month or so I call at least 20 attorneys and law clinics on a list the court has provided to me, but they all turn me down) and I have to wait to seek pro bono assistance from others to help me in my Federal Court pleadings.
5. This is just for a short extension of time. I believe I have good cause for an extension of time, and the request has not been made for the purposes of delay or harassment. In fact, no defendant has been served (the Trial Court would not allow it) and no defendant has filed an appearance, and therefore no defendant will be prejudiced by this Extension of Time.
6. All statements made in the accompanying Motion are in fact true and accurate.
