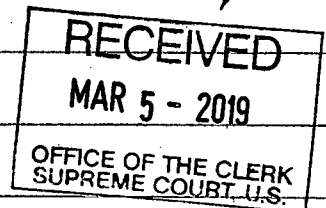

APPLICATION TO EXTEND TIME TO

FILE PETITION FOR CERTIORARI

RELIEF SOUGHT

Muhammed Rafiq (petitioner) kindly requests that Justice for the Fifth Circuit, extend the time for filing a petition for writ of certiorari in the matter of United States of America v. Muhammed Rafiq, appeal 17-11057.



GROUND FOR RELIEF

1. The Supreme Court will have jurisdiction over this matter because 28 U.S.C. §1254 gives this Court jurisdiction over an appeal of a final judgment of a United States Court of Appeals;
2. On Dec 3, 2018, the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals upheld the District court's decision;
3. Under Supreme Court Rule 13.1, time for filing of a petition for writ of certiorari in this matter expires on March 3, 2019;
4. Petitioner was previously in the custody of Bureau of Prisons and currently in custody of Immigration and Customs enforcement. The change in custody deprived petitioner access to the records due to no fault of his own;
5. Petitioner has recently requested these prior records from district and appellate Courts;
