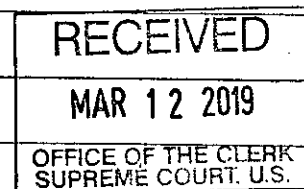

I'm writing because I'm wishing to File a writ of Certiorari, and the facility that I'm in requires that I get a letter from the court with a deadline to receive additional access to the law library. 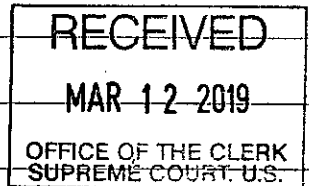

I'm Writing because I have a 4th Amendment Question that I would like to present for review in a writ of Certiorari I'm halfway to completion and need an extension because I've been having an extremely hard time getting access to the law library here at this facility.
