REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

To the Honorable Justice Mr. Alito:

I intend to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in the Supreme Court with respect to the judgment of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit in Appeal No. 17-41165, United States v. Flavio Tamez (USDC No. 2:17-cv-89, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Corpus Christi Division). The appellate judgment was issued on 12/13/2018, see attached; a timely petition for rehearing was denied on 2/19/2019, see attached. Thus my petition in this Court is due 90 days thereafter, on or about 5/19/2019. This Court has jurisdiction to consider said petition under 28 U.S.C. §1254(1).

A single Justice may extend the time to file by up to 60 days for good cause, Supreme Court Rule 13. As the petitioner (appellant below), I hereby respectfully request an extension of 60 days. I have been seeking representation and to date am unable to secure counsel to bring my petition in the Supreme Court. My search is ongoing and I will file a petition pro se if need be. Therefore, I assert that there exists good cause to allow the requested extension.
