I am counsel for the respondent in this case. On February 28, 2020, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case. Unless extended by the Court, the response would be due on March 30, 2020. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 25 days, to and including April 24, 2020.
