Pursuant to this Court's orders of March 19 and April 15, 2020, and the Covid-19 Guidance issued by the Clerk's Office on April 17, 2020, petitioner moves the Court to delay distribution of the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case for three weeks, from May 26, 2020, the currently scheduled distribution date, to June 16, 2020.

The petition for a writ of certiorari was docketed on March 5, 2020, and after a 30-day extension of time respondent State of Florida filed the brief in opposition to the petition on May 6, 2020. In light of the work interference caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, petitioner will have difficulty filing a reply brief on the ordinary schedule. A three-week delay in distribution of the petition would allow petitioner to prepare a reply brief that fully addresses the points raised by the State in its opposition to the petition, and therefore that is of greater assistance to the Court.
