Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on March 30, 2020, and placed on the docket on April 2, 2020. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on June 3, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including August 14, 2020, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the government is presently undertaking a review of whether to retain the policy that is the subject of the petition for a writ of certiorari, and the government's decision at the conclusion of that review may moot this litigation. The government anticipates completing its review by the end of July 2020.

Counsel for petitioner consents to this further extension.
