Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on March 30, 2020, and placed on the docket on April 2, 2020. The government's response is now due, after five extensions, on February 19, 2021. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including March 19, 2021, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary in light of recent developments that bear on the petition for a writ of certiorari. As the government previously informed the Court when requesting extensions of time to respond to the petition, the Department of Defense has been undertaking a review of whether to retain the policy that is the subject of the petition. The Department recently completed that review, and it rescinded the challenged policy on February 3, 2021. The government now respectfully requests additional time to prepare its response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in light of these changed circumstances.

Counsel for petitioners consents to this further extension.
