Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to this Court's order dated March 19, 2020, petitioner in the abovecaptioned case respectfully requests that the Court delay distribution of the petition for a writ of certiorari for 7 days. The petition is currently scheduled for distribution no earlier than August 26, 2020. If this Court were to grant the requested 7-day delay, distribution of the petition would occur no earlier than September 2, 2020. The conference date—September 29, 2020—would remain unchanged.

Petitioner requires the additional time to file its reply due to the logistical difficulties and dislocations caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, including the need to coordinate among multiple law firms each operating remotely. Counsel for respondents authorized me to say that they do not object to the delay in distribution.
