
I represent Respondent AAF Holdings LLC in the above-captioned case. The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on May 18, 2020, and placed on the Court's docket on May 20, 2020. The docket reflects that any brief in opposition is currently due on June 19, 2020.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4 and this Court's March 19, 2020 Order regarding filing deadlines during the COVID-19 public health crisis, we respectfully request a 30-day extension of time within which to file the brief in opposition of AAF Holdings LLC to and including July 20, 2020.

This extension is justified because as new counsel to the matter in this Court, I require additional time to familiarize myself with the record and arguments below and to prepare the brief in opposition and need time to become familiar with the case. An extension is also required in light of the disruption caused by the ongoing public health crisis, *see* March 19, 2020 Order, and in light of the demands of other matters being handled by counsel. Finally, at least one *amicus curiae* will be filing in support of the petition, and additional time will permit a coordinated opposition that also addresses *amicus*'s arguments.
