We represent the respondent with respect to the above-referenced petition for certiorari. A response is currently due on July 13, 2020. Respondent respectfully requests that the time to file a response be extended by 28 days, to and including Monday, August 10, 2020. The extension is warranted because undersigned counsel, Steve Art, has been occupied with time-sensitive briefing in other appeals, including *Vargas v.
