I am writing as Respondent's counsel pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 15 and 30.4 seeking an extension of time, up to and including December 6, 2019 to file a Brief in Opposition to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit's Decision in C.D.
