Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for Robbin L. Fulton, George Peake, and Timothy Shannon ("Respondents"). Mr. Howard filed a notice in the Seventh Circuit indicating his intention not to participate in the appeal in that court. On September 17, 2019, the City of Chicago filed a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit, affirming the judgments entered in the Respondents' respective bankruptcy cases in their favor and against the City of Chicago ("Petitioner"). Respondents' brief in opposition is due on October 18, 2019.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 15.3 and Rule 30.4, I write to request a thirty-day extension of time to file the brief in opposition, through and including November 18, 2019. This request is not made for purposes of delay, but is necessitated by the fact that I am currently working on a petition for rehearing or rehearing en banc in the case *Bush v. United States of America*, No. 16-3244 (7th Cir.), which will be due on October 4, 2019.

I have contacted counsel for the Petitioner, Mr. Craig Goldblatt, who has indicated that he has no objection to the extension.
