Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent the Respondents, Lindie L. Banks and Erica LeBlanc, in the above-captioned matter. The petition for writ of certiorari was filed on October 2, 2019, and Respondents waived their response on October 29, 2019. The Court requested a response on November 18, 2019, and it is currently due on December 18, 2019.

I respectfully request a 30 day extension under Rule 30.4. No prior extension request has been made. This request is being made due to, among other workload commitments, that on December 6, 2019, the District Court in this case issued an order denying in its entirety Respondents' motion for class certification. Respondents have until December 20, 2019 to file a request for permission to appeal that ruling under Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(f). The additional time will allow Respondents to timely file their Rule 23(f) petition and will ensure sufficient and adequate time to respond to the petition for writ of certiorari. Petitioners take no position on the extension request.

With a 30 day extension, the response deadline would be January 17, 2020.
