

APPLICATION TO EXTEND TIME

I, Tasheena Stewart, *pro se* litigant, both humbly and respectfully request from The Supreme Court Of The United States a 60 day extension to file an appeal from The Order given by the The First Circuit Court on February 7, 2019, Case No: 18-1366. The 90 day timeframe to file ends on May 8, 2019. This request is being filed before the due date.

I, Tasheena Stewart was employed by Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center and Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital from June of 2011 until June of 2013. During my employment there I was an outstanding employee this was recognized and confirmed by official evaluations prepared and submitted to my employee file by my supervisor. During my employment there the very supervisor who gave me such great reviews both discriminated against me and began to harass me. I was discriminated against for my race, skin color, size and background. I was harassed sexually and intimidated daily. I complained both to Human Resources and the head of the Pathology department where I worked. They both agreed that I was being harassed and discriminated against and said that they would handle the situation. As time passed the situation only worsened, after multiple meetings with Human Resources and the head of the Pathology department and no resolve I told the institution that I was going to resign because it had become unbearable. They convinced me to stay, promising productive change. Ultimately this supervisor made false complaints against me and the institution supported her, although I



had documentation between all parties supporting the facts, the institution unjustly terminated my employment.

I am requesting an extension because as a *pro se* litigant my resources are extremely limited and I do not have everything I need to put together a proper appeal for The Supreme Court. I have recently been offered some professional help which I feel will really help me to submit a strong appeal to The Court. I am very late in my request as I was just offered this help that I desperately need. I am also very late with my request as I did not understand the difference between the Order Of Court date versus the Mandate date. I would ask The Court to please forgive my inexperience and lack of legal knowledge and understanding, and please grant me 60 additional days to properly file and utilize recently offered help.
