JUDGMENT

On October 25, 2012, Albert Duval Gray appeared before the Honorable Terrence W. Boyle, U.S. District Judge in the Eastern District of North Carolina, and upon an earlier plea of guilty to Possession With the Intent to Distribute a Quantity of Cocaine Base (Crack) was sentenced to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons for a term of 78 months. Additionally, it was ordered by the court that the defendant be placed on supervised release for 36 months upon release from imprisonment. Albert Duval Gray was released from custody and the term of supervised release commenced on June 16, 2016.

From evidence presented at the revocation hearing on August 13, 2018, the court finds as a fact that Albert Duval Gray, who is appearing before the court with counsel, has violated the terms and conditions of the judgment as follows:

1. Criminal conduct.
2. Possessing a controlled substance.
3. Criminal conduct.
4. Possessing a controlled substance.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the supervised release term heretofore granted be revoked, and the defendant is ordered committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons or its authorized representative for imprisonment for a period of 24 months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk provide the U.S. Marshal a copy of this Judgment and same shall serve as the commitment herein.
