MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

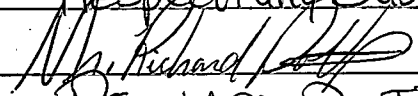
The petitioner asks leave to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 12.2.

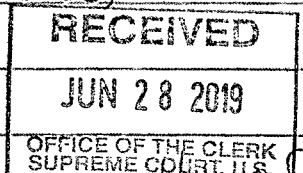

FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

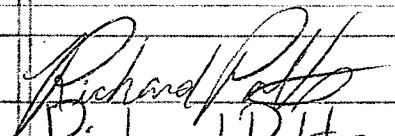
RICHARD POTTS states:

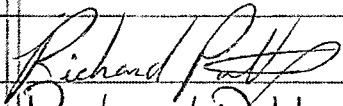
