MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT
OF CERTIORARI TO THIS COURT

I, ANDREW M. CONDON, PRO SE, RESPECTFULLY MOVES THIS
HONORABLE COURT TO ENTER AN ORDER GRANTING ME
AN EXTENSION OF TIME, AND IN SUPPORT STATES AS FOLLOWS:

1. I AM THE PETITIONER IN THE ABOVE CAPTIONED CASE.
2. I AM NOT REPRESENTED BY AN ATTORNEY IN THIS CASE.
3. I AM A PRISONER IN THE CUSTODY OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT
OF CORRECTIONS AT MENARD CORRECTIONAL CENTER, PO BOX 1000
MENARD, IL 62259.

4. ON NOVEMBER 28, 2018 MY "P.L.A." WAS DENIED BY
THE ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT. (WRIT DUE ^{90 DAYS -} FEBRUARY 26, 2019)

5. I HAVE BEEN UNABLE TO MAKE THE NECESSARY
RESEARCH IN ORDER TO PREPARE AND FILE A PETITION
FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI; BECAUSE:

A) DUE TO HOLIDAYS AND INSTITUTIONAL LOCKDOWNS
I HAVE ONLY HAD ACCESS TO THE LAW LIBRARY 2 TIMES
SINCE MY PLA'S DENIAL, UP TO AND INCLUDING FEBRUARY 5, 2019.

B) I REQUESTED "DEADLINE" STATUS FOR THE LAW LIBRARY
AT THE BEGINNING OF DECEMBER 2018, HOWEVER

THIS REQUEST TOOK 2 WEEKS BEFORE I WAS CALLED ON THE 3RD WEEK OF DECEMBER 2018.

C) DUE TO CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEARS (HOLIDAYS) I WAS NOT CALLED FOR THE LAST 2 LAW LIBRARY CALL LINES OF 2018.

D) DUE TO THE 2 WEEK INSTITUTIONAL LOCKDOWN, JANUARY 1-15, 2019, I HAD NO ACCESS TO THE LEGAL MATERIALS NEEDED TO SUPPORT MY CLAIMS BEING SET FORTH IN MY "WRIT OF CERT" (eg. LAW BOOKS, CASE LAW, FEDERAL RULES-WRIT OF CERT, COPIES, ect...)

E) THE ACCESS TO THE LAW LIBRARY IS LIMITED AT BEST AS IT'S AVAILABLE 1 TIME PER WEEK FOR 1 1/2 HOURS, WHICH INCLUDES TRAVEL TIME (LINE MOVEMENT) SO AT MOST EACH LAW LIBRARY VISIT IS 2 HOUR IN WHICH TO DO ANY MEANINGFUL RESEARCH FOR MY "WRIT" OR ANY LEGAL WORK.

F) I DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO THE FACTUAL/LEGAL MATERIALS (TRANSCRIPTS, BRIEFS, MOTIONS, ect...) I NEED TO DEVELOPE AND PROVE MY ALLEGATIONS IN THE AFOREMENTIONED PETITION (WRIT) AS THESE ITEMS ARE IN LEGAL STORAGE (DUE TO CELL SIZE).

6. I NEED MORE TIME IN WHICH TO PREPARE AND FILE MY PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI IN THIS COURT.

WHEREFORE, I, ANDREW M. CONDON, RESPECTFULLY REQUEST AN EXTENSION OF 60 DAYS FROM THIS DATE, TO FILE MY PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THIS COURT AND PRAYS THIS COURT ENTERS SAID EXTENSION IN AN ORDER TO ASSIST ME IN GAINING ACCESS TO ALL NEEDED LEGAL ITEMS TO SUPPORT MY CLAIMS.
