

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Arkansas Department of correction issued inmates tablets. With these tablets inmates could look up other inmates charges and legal cases. A year inmates found out I had HIV and a sex charge. They threatened to Stab me. I escaped and went to Security who placed me in the hole under investigation. In less than 24 hours later Defendant Harris ordered me to population to get assaulted I refused and Defendant Felts wrote me a major disciplinary and Defendant Golden found me guilty. I did hole time and 60 days restriction. ADC Policy forbids me to be forced into population while under investigation. Defendant Kelley refused me protective custody because the ADC does not have it. Now I have a State wide hit on my life and can never go to population. So I am in a Restrictive Housing Status for the next 15 years with the most violent inmates in Arkansas because of the ADC issuing tablets.

This case should be looked at because it shows the lower courts unfair and one sided treatment of the AGC

CONCLUSION

The petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted.
