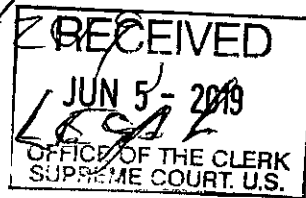

PAPERS.

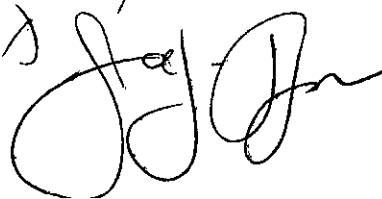
