Pursuant to this Court's Rule 30.3, STEVEN GOLDSMITH, P.A. and STEVEN M. GOLDSMITH, ("Respondents",) respectfully requests a seven (7) day extension of time, up to and including October 18, 2019, within which to file a response to the petition for writ of certiorari (the "Petition") filed by, EKATERINI ALEXOPOULOS ("Petitioner"), in this case. As directed by the Court, the time for Respondents to file a response to the petition currently expires on October 11, 2019.

1. Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on May 7, 2019 and placed on the docket August 2, 2019.
2. By rule, a response to the petition was due on or before September 3, 2019.
3. On August 22, 2019, Respondents requested by correspondence, an extension of time to file a response to the petition. The court granted the request, extending the time to respond to the petition to October 3, 2019.
4. On September 27, 2019, Respondents filed their Application for Extension of Time to Respond to Petition for Writ of Certiorari. The court granted the application, extending the response time to October 11, 2019.
5. Due to the undersigned's heavy litigation schedule, other professional responsibilities, and the intervening Jewish Holy Day which directly affected this law firm, counsel for the Respondents requests an extension of time of seven (7) days from October 11, 2019, within which to prepare and file a response to the petition, to wit: on or before October 18, 2019.

6. The undersigned counsel certifies that Lysa Friedlieb, Esq., and his law firm's staff have attempted to confer with Petitioner multiple times by telephone and email, regarding the requested extension. However, Petitioner has chosen not to respond to any of the repeated attempts to confer. See attached **Exhibit "A"**.

7. For the reasons stated above, Respondents respectfully requests the time to file a response to the petition in this case be extended seven (7) days up to and including October 18, 2019.

8. Considering the issues on appeal do not involve depravation of liberty, it is respectfully submitted that Petitioner would not be prejudiced by this short extension to prepare and file the Brief in Opposition.


