

the dictates of 21 U.S.C. 848(q)(10)(A), 18 U.S.C. 3006A(1), and 18 U.S.C. 3599 after Mr. Barton satisfied those Courts that he was indigent, without the means or funds to hire counsel to represent him in connection with the trial and appeal of the above captioned cause.

3. Mr. Barton has been incarcerated since his arrest in the fall of 1991, and has been sentenced to death by the State of Missouri. As a result, Mr. Barton continues to have no means or funds to bear the costs of an appeal, and has no ability to generate such funds.

4. The ends of justice will best be served by the Court granting the relief sought in this Request.

WHEREFORE, Walter Barton prays this Honorable Court to make and enter its Order granting him leave of Court to proceed, before this Court, *in forma pauperis*,
