REQUEST FOR LEAVE OF COURT TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

have no means or funds to bear the costs of an appeal, and has no ability to generate

such funds.

4. The ends of justice will best be served by the Court granting the relief sought

in this Request.

Order granting him leave of Court to proceed, before this Court, in forma pauperis,
