Extension of Time Request

Two single mothers (Regan Lally and Temmi Kramer) and our children, Pro Se Petitioners, are respectfully requesting an extension of 90 days, in the above referenced matter.

The Pro Se Petitioners filed a Motion for leave to proceed *In Forma Pauperis* based upon our dire financial circumstances and upon IFP status currently granted in New York State Courts. See attached NYS Court rulings granting *Forma Pauperis* status and our financial affidavits, marked as Exhibit "1".

By decision dated October 21, 2019 (attached), the Supreme Court denied our unopposed Motion to proceed *In Forma Pauperis* and gave the Petitioners only two weeks from the date of receiving the October 21, 2019 decision (until November 12, 2019), to pay the \$300.00 filing fee and, more importantly, undertaking a very costly (over \$8,000.00) reprinting in pamphlet format and re-serving all Defendants the Writ of Certiorari and Appendix, in compliance with Rule 33.1 of the Court. See Exhibit "2".

It appears that the U.S. Supreme Court denied *Forma Pauperis* status to Petitioners based upon an error in the U.S. Supreme Court Clerk's Office that incorrectly lists Regan Lally as "Attorney for Petitioners". See attached error listing one Petitioner as Attorney, Exhibit "3".


All of the Defendants received the typeset (Times New Roman, 12 point) Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in May 2019. Some have not answered, some sent waivers, and one Brief in Opposition was filed two months ago, in compliance with the past due briefing schedule of this Honorable Court. The Petitioners incurred an excessive expense of over two thousand dollars (>\$2,000.00) in printing and service fees of our Writ of Certiorari and Appendix to all Defendants.

It would be unconscionable to cause Petitioners to incur additional costs of over \$8,000.00 in printing in pamphlet format, which is logically impossible (as we lack the time to November 12, 2019), even if we could afford this expense. It would be a great injustice to Petitioner women, children and the environment for the unnecessary excessive reprinting.

Attached is the Petitioners Motion to renew and reargue leave to proceed *in Forma Pauperis*.

I most respectfully request that Your Honor allow Petitioners a 90 day extension.
