**PETITIONER'S MOTION AND AFFIRMATION
FOR
LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

Petitioner, Alfonso Sanchez, through counsel, respectfully moves for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and submits as follows:

1. This case is before the Court on a petition for writ of certiorari.
2. Alfonso Sanchez is in prison pending a capital re-trial.
3. During post-conviction proceedings after Petitioner's first trial, he was found to be IFP by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania on April 30, 2014. A copy of that Order is attached.
4. After Petitioner was granted a new trial, the Bucks County Court of Common Pleas provided Petitioner with court appointed counsel in April 2017.
5. Petitioner remains incarcerated today and there has been no change in his financial status. He is without funds to secure the services necessary to proceed in this Court (e.g., printing fees, etc.) or to pay any fees.
6. Undersigned counsel affirms that all statements related above are true and correct

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests that this Court allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

AND NOW, this 30 th day April, 2014, upon consideration of Petitioner's


Motion for Leave to Proceed *in Forma Pauperis* and for Appointment of Counsel, it is hereby
