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PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR COURT TO EXTEND HIS  
TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR REVIEW

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PETITIONER, TONY D. WALKER, APPEARING PRO SE, AND PURSUANT TO SCR 30. 2, 3, REQUEST THAT THE COURT EXTEND HIS TIME TO FILE HIS PETITION FOR REVIEW BY 60 (SIXTY DAYS) FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS.

PETITIONER'S APPEAL IN THIS CASE WAS DISMISSED ON MARCH 11, 2019. SEE PETITIONER'S DECLARATION AT 6. HIS DEADLINE FOR FILING HIS PETITION FOR REVIEW IN THIS COURT IS JUNE 9, 2019, SEE SCR #13. HE CANNOT MEET THIS DEADLINE BECAUSE THE PRISON HE IS CONFINED IN HAS NOT APPROVED HIS REQUESTS FOR LEGAL LOANS AND COPIES OF LEGAL DOCUMENTS. PETITIONER IS IN THE PROCESS OF COMPLETING THE ADMINISTRATIVE GRIEVANCE PROCESS, HE HAS NO CONTROL OVER THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC) OR ANY OF THEIR OPERATIONS, AND MUST WAIT UNTIL THEY ADDRESS HIS REQUESTS AND COMPLAINTS SO THAT HE CAN FILE THE PROPER AND CORRECT DOCUMENTS WITH THE COURT, AND FOR THESE ACTIONS HE IS REQUESTING A SIXTY DAY (60) EXTENSION TO FILE HIS PETITION FOR REVIEW.

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FURTHERMORE, THIS ACTION IS VERY IMPORTANT WHERE 28 U.S.C. § 2403(a) MAY APPLY BECAUSE THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF AN ACT OF CONGRESS WILL BE DRAWN INTO QUESTION.

WHEREFORE, PETITIONER PRAYS THAT THIS COURT WILL GRANT HIS MOTION AND EXTEND THE TIME FOR WHICH HE MUST FILE HIS PETITION FOR REVIEW BY 60 DAYS.
