

## FACTS

Petitioner desires to file a Writ of Certiorari after a Decision of Affirmance by the Nevada Supreme Court.

He believes the Nevada Revised Statutes support his position in the underlying matter.

Petitioner first attended Arbitration. He appealed the decision to the District Court. Relief was denied to him. When he filed his Appeal, it was first heard by the Court of Appeals in Nevada. He filed a Petition for Review with the Nevada Supreme Court.

On January 25, 2019, he obtained an ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REVIEW. See Exhibit "1".

Petitioner is aware there is a requirement that the Writ of Certiorari is be filed within 120 days of said date. However, Petitioner is 80 years old, he is not an attorney, and he is surviving on social security income of \$980 per month. Petitioner has not begun typing of his Brief at this time, and he is aware that the 120 days shall run on or about May 24, 2019. He is concerned that he will have a good amount of Appendix exhibits, and it will take him more time than is allotted in this matter.

Petitioner will also be required to submit forma pauperis documents seeking to waive his fees, which will also take away from his time to prepare the brief.

Any and all research will take him longer than it would an attorney, or a legal profession.


