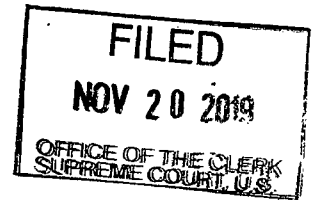

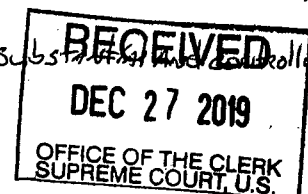

MOTION FOR REHEARING

COMES NOW, PETITIONER, GLEN T. JONES, JR., respectfully moves this Court for Rehearing on the grounds that this Court has overlooked the crucial differences between the Constitutional division of the Eleventh Circuit's Court decisional matters in this case, based contrary to the U.S. Constitution's Fifth Amendment's Double Jeopardy Clause and those guarantees, unreasonably in the Eleventh Circuit's reasoning in rejecting the Fifth Amendment guarantee; controlling constitutional law and, changing the governing power of the U.S. Constitutional Fifth Amendment's standards of this Court and other Circuit Courts across the United States, by its actions in agreeing that Double Jeopardy was infringed, but denying relief based on erroneous presumptions the statute of limitations has run out.
