Dear Clerk Harris,

The Court has requested that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts file a brief in response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-named case by September 23, 2019. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, the Commonwealth respectfully requests that the time allowed to file its brief be extended by 60 days, to November 22, 2019. Counsel for Petitioner has assented to this request.

This request is based on the need for additional time to prepare a helpful response to the petition.
