Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 7, 2019. The government's response is now due, after three extensions, on February 7, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including March 9, 2020, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates. In addition, the government has filed an application in the district court to dismiss petitioner's indictment under Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 48(a), and that application remains pending. See D. Ct. Doc. 143 (Dec. 5, 2019).

Counsel for petitioner does not oppose this further extension.
