Defendant John Douglas was sentenced to 240 months in prison after being convicted by a jury of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Douglas has filed a motion to vacate, set aside, or correct his sentence under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Having reviewed the motion and the government's response, the Court will schedule an evidentiary hearing and appoint counsel for Douglas. *See Rule 8(c), Rules Governing Section 2255 Proceedings.*

ORDER

Based on the foregoing, and on all of the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Court hereby appoints the Office of the Federal Defender to represent defendant in connection with his 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion. The Office of the Federal Defender may assign either a lawyer from the office or a panel attorney to assist defendant.

2. An evidentiary hearing will be held on Friday, September 25, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom 14E of the United States Courthouse in Minneapolis.
3. No later than Friday, September 18, 2015, the parties must submit to the Court and serve on each other a witness list, an exhibit list, and copies of all exhibits to be introduced at the hearing.
