VERIFYING TIMELY MAILING

Jason Simon files this affidavit, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 29, to verify that the filing of his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari was timely and proper.

Under the penalty of perjury, pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. § 1746, Jason Simon states the following:

1. I am the Petitioner in the above-captioned case.
2. On Sunday, December 23, 2018, at 7:10 p.m., I handed a package containing my petition for a writ of certiorari to Officer Jones in Building 5 for mailing to this Court, at One First St. NE, Washington, DC 20543. This package had prepaid first-class postage affixed, as well as a U.S. Postal Service tracking number of 7014 2870-0002 3259 5722.
3. On September 16, 2019, I received a letter from the

Court Clerk indicating that my original petition was never received by the Court.

4. The letter was in response to my attempt to file a supplemental brief, which was rejected on the ground that no petition was pending. (The supplement is also being refiled.)


5. Subsequently on September 16, 2019, my mother replied to my request for tracking of the package I had mailed to the Court on December 23. She wrote that the U.S.P.S. website shows the package having been "Delivered 1/2/19 to Washington D.C."

6. I also sent a copy of every filing made in this Court to the Office of the Solicitor General on the dates noted on each associated certificate of service.

7. None of the mailings was returned to me as undeliverable by the U.S.P.S.
