Jurisdiction

Pursuant to: 28 U.S.C § 1257 (a) A Right being denied by the State of Texas Courts, Guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution is claimed. Pursuant to: Sup. Crim. Rule 13(1), the cause is within its 90 day date deadline from the entry of the final judgment on May 10, 2019. Pursuant to Sup. Crim. Rule 30.(2), the request for an extension is made before the minimum 10 day mandate of Rule 13(1).

Judgement

The Judgement sought reviewed is a Termination of Parental Rights Suit. Cause: 265,705-A.

Opinion
