Dear Mr. Harris,

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, undersigned counsel hereby requests an extension of time in which to respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case. The extension is justified for the following reasons:

The petition was filed on October 23, 2019. On December 13, 2019, the Court requested a response to be filed by January 13, 2020. Undersigned counsel did not represent the State in the court below and would benefit from additional time to become familiar with the facts, history, and law of this case. The petition also raises questions similar to those pending in this Court's cases *Sharp v. Murphy*, No. 17-1107, and *McGirt v. Oklahoma*, No. 18-9526. Additional time is required for counsel to present to the Court the appropriate course of action in these interrelated cases.

For these reasons, Respondent respectfully requests an additional thirty days, or until February 13, 2020, in which to file its response.
