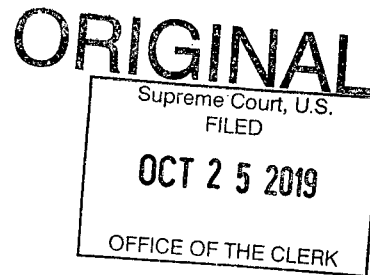

## STATEMENT OF THE CASE

University of Pennsylvania running high sensitive human subject testing in public without warning or informed consent. Plaintiff sued.

Lower Courts dismissed saying no federal jurisdiction.

But obviously, in light most favorable to Plaintiff federal jurisdiction applies.

1. Violation of Federal Statute + State Law + Federal/State Case/tort law

2. Federal Funding - Explaining - Brings in the U.S. Government as a Party because obviously the U.S. Government cannot fund research that infringes on the rights of Americans under Federal and State law as a matter of Due Process

Complaint not read/applied in light most favorable to Plaintiff/non-moving party.

REVERSE + REMAND.


## REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION
